

NOTICE: UPDATE ON ESAN WORLD CONGRESS (EWC) COURT LITIGATION

We, (Genesis Inihbunu, Desmond Okougbo, Priscilla Ikharebha, Micheal Jarman Agbator, Frederick Abienekpen, Simon Ogbeide and Patrick Emuankhagbon) as co-defendant on the litigation brought against us by Jacob Unubun and co on behalf of EWC, wish to update the congress on the status of the court case.

The court case was initiated on April 29, 2013 and as a result of this court litigation, the activities of the Congress in relation to Esan National convention and the enhancement of the development of our motherland have been impaired.

The summary judgement was delivered on March 3, 2017. The appeal that followed was discharged for lack of merit on April 17, 2017. For the interest of transparency, the conclusive verdict of the court as delivered on March 3, 2017 and April 17, 2017 are hereby attached for your information.

With this development therefore, we the co-defendants on behalf of the Congress are please to inform you that based on the court directives, EWC is discharged of all and any legal limitation to commence its congressional, communal progressive initiatives, and activities.
