

Dear President,

On behalf of Esan World Congress (EWC), it is pertinent to inform you and your local association that the court case perpetuated by Jacob Unubun & co. against our loyal members (Genesis Inihbunu, Desmond Okougbo, Priscilla Ikharebha, Micheal Jarman Agbator, Frederick Abienekpen, Simon Ogbeide and Patrick Emuankhagbon) as co-defendant is finally settled.

The summary judgement was delivered on March 3, 2017. The appeal that followed was discharged for lack of merit on April 17, 2017. For the interest of transparency, the conclusive verdict of the court as delivered on March 3, 2017 and April 17, 2017 are hereby attached for your information.

Please, be informed that EWC's money totaling **\$42,614.89** is in the custody of the Court and due for release to the Organization on satisfying the Court directive of a constituted group of leadership.

It is evidently obvious that the court litigation impaired the congress ability to organize its annual Esan National convention and other related activities for the past four years.

Thank you all for your support, endurance, and believe in the common cause of EWC. If the mantle of local association leadership have change hands, we employ you to forward this notice to the appropriate individual.

Based on the court directives, EWC is discharged of all and any legal limitation to commence its congressional, communal progressive initiatives, and other activities.

To this end, EWC needs ideas from all associate members of the Congress, local Associations, the defunct Executive Council, defunct Council of Presidents (COP) and the defunct Board of Trustee (BOT) in the following areas:

- I. Suggestions and ideas on how best to reconvene the congress,**
- II. Suggestions on how best to heal the inflated psychological, social and emotional injury the court case has inflicted on individuals and local associations,**
- III. An immediate activity that can entrench the desired unity among the community,**
- IV. How to re-engineer harmonious coexistence**
- V. How on forging a new course of action for the congress**
